Although every effort is made to create a safe environment, I realize there is always a risk of accident. As a result, I, the parent/legal guardian of the participant(s), hereby knowingly and freely assume all risks, both known and unknown even if arising from negligence of others, associated with willing participation in any and all activities through Imagine That! INC., and **ANY and ALL** affiliated parties. While we strive to make all activities as safe as possible, I understand that there is some element of risk associated with indoor and outdoor play equipment, classroom and camp activities.

Further, I sign this Waiver of Liability with the understanding that by voluntarily participating in the Imagine That! INC program I, on behalf of myself and the participant(s), and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives, and next of kin, voluntarily and expressly release, indemnify, forever discharge, and **HEREBY HOLD HARMLESS** Imagine That! INC., its owners, their management, directors, officers, members, employees, agents and **ANY and ALL** affiliated parties from any claims, damages, cost or expenses including those of attorney fees and medical fees, and liability for any such personal injury, disability, death or loss or damage to person or property to the fullest extent of the law.

In case of an emergency involving my child that, in the opinion of the program personnel, school or business representatives present, requires immediate medical or surgical attention, I hereby grant permission to Imagine That! Behavior Contract: Campers are expected to display appropriate behavior during our summer camps. In order to keep campers engaged in the process of interactive learning, distractions must be kept to a minimum. Many activities require a cooperative effort. The more campers try to get along well with one another and their counselors, the more enjoyable camp is for everyone involved. Please review these guidelines for behavior that will help your child enjoy Imagine That!

- Pay attention to counselors and follow directions.
- If you have a question or comment, raise your hand; do not interrupt.
- Be respectful to other campers, listen to and encourage them.
- No fighting, hitting, spitting, name-calling, or any other form of harassing or disrespectful behavior.
- Ask permission before touching anything that is not handed to you.
- Participate actively, play and stay engaged during activities. Be patient and wait quietly between them.
- Have fun!

In the event that a camper has trouble with his/her behavior, they may be removed from the activity at hand. If the camper is repeatedly disruptive, parents will be notified. In the event that the previous actions do not improve the situation and where the behavior is such that it detracts from other campers' enjoyment of camp, the camper may be transferred to another program at the same or different location if there is one during the same week at no cost, NOT to a later week. Regardless, there are no refunds in this event.

Option R14 and STR 10 addendum: In robot-building safety is very important. In addition to the above guidelines, there are extra guidelines for the soldering station and rotary tool station. Work done in these stations is closely supervised and performed in small groups.

- Safety goggles and gloves must be worn at all times.
- Equipment must be used properly.
- No rough-housing.
- No chatter, only questions pertaining to the task at hand.

If a camper breaks one of these rules, they will be removed from the station for that period (until after the next break) and be asked to write a formal apology. Parents will be notified of the incident at the end of the day. If a camper continues to be disruptive outside of the station, parents will be contacted and asked to take the camper home or to place him in another program at the same location. The camper will not be allowed to return to the robot-building program, as it is not an appropriate place for him or her. The camper may be transferred to another program at the same or different location if there is one during the same week at no cost, NOT at a later week. Regardless, there are no refunds in this event.
