

# Additional Information for Parents of Minecraft Camp for Ages 7-10

---

## **Pre-requisites:**

- Your child must have played a minimum of 10 hours of Minecraft before coming to camp on Monday morning.
- At least HALF of this time must be played ***on a computer***. There are completely different controls between the Xbox, touchpad and computer. We don't want your child to be frustrated during the first several hours of camp!

A large portion of this camp will include typing short scripts into the "Command Block." Therefore, a familiarity with a computer keyboard is strongly recommended.

Please be aware with the second program that we recommend that your student **not** keep their scores on-line since they will require additional information.

We will be using MinecraftEdu, which creates a safe server environment in which the instructor can control where students build, freeze and un-freeze players, and broadcast instructions across all computers in the server.

In order for your child to continue playing Minecraft at home between classes and after camp is over, you will need to purchase a license from Minecraft, if you have not already done so. You can purchase a license at [minecraft.net](http://minecraft.net) for \$26.84. Once you have purchased the license, downloading the game is free! You can also play the demo version for free on the website. We will have a licensed version that the children can use during camp.
