PART 1



PAPER MACHE BOXES AND GATHERING TOOLS

Students will use their creativity skills to design their paper box into a sewing box. Students will also learn about and gather their sewing tools.

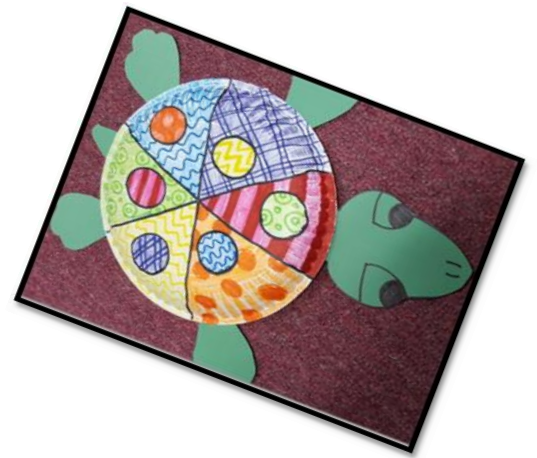
ARTIST PORTFOLIO

Students will practice the good habits of an artist as we create a means of protecting our work while expressing themselves with fun decorations.

SOCK DONUT AND PIN CUSHION

Students will practice using the whip stitch and applique stitch as they create a fun and educational pin cushion!

PART 2



STITCHES BOOK

Students will learn the importance of different stitches, where they should be used and have the opportunity to practice each one of them.

COLOR WHEEL TURTLE

Students will create a mandala using the color wheel. The goal is to help students understand the different combinations of colors and the proper vocabulary to understand this. The vocabulary includes terms such as Primary, Secondary, Complementary, Analogous, Tertiary, Hue, Value, Tint and Shade.

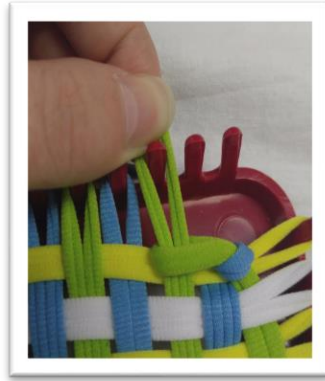
SWATCH BOOK

Students will learn the importance of different types of fabric and which kinds to use for various types of outfits.

KALEIDOSCOPIES

Students will learn about, create and design kaleidoscopes.

PART 3



DESIGN DOLL DRESSES

Using inspiration from fashion magazines, information about fashion styles, and scrap fabric available, the students will design an outfit for a doll.

TILE PAINTINGS TO MUSIC

Students will learn about multidisciplinary art while painting their interpretation of music onto tiles.

SEW DOLL DRESSES

Based on their fashion designs, the students will now create their doll outfits.

WEAVING WITH LOOM FRAMES

Students will learn to use a weaving loom to make a potholder into a frame for their artwork or into a water bottle holder.

PART 4



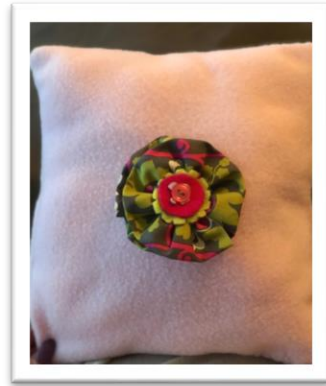
LED BAGS

Students will use a pattern to cut out a bag and use the running stitch to sew it together. Once finished the students will add LED lights to make it extraordinary!

JACKSON POLLOCK PAINTING

Students will learn about famous artist, Jackson Pollock, while creating a group effort splatter painting. Messy but FUN!

PART 5



SCRAP FABRIC PENCIL CASE

In this project, students will use what they have learned so far to make a decorative fabric pencil case. They will use a pattern to help them cut out their fabric, which will reinforce to students the importance of using design patterns in sewing.

MONET WATER SCENES

Students will learn about famous artist, Claude Monet while creating water scenes of their own. As they learn about water color paints they will learn techniques to keep desired areas paint free.

TISSUE PAPER ART

Students will experiment with an unusual art medium, tissue paper, while having the opportunity to take creative artistic liberties.

MINI PILLOW WITH FABRIC FLOWER

Students will use the running stitch and ladder stitch to create a mini pillow and then create and attach a scrap fabric flower using the running stitch and applique stitch.
